- K. Stand that supports other equipment when heating (see front table)
- L. Curved glass piece used to cover glassware or hold small amounts of chemical
- M. Supports beaker when heating, and spreads flame for even heating
- N. Measures mass

- O. Holds test tubes
- P. Heats with a hot flame
- Q. Grasps and picks up smaller glassware or solids.
- R. Add liquids drop by drop
- S. Cleans test tubes
- T. Holds chemicals, measures volumes of liquids less accurately
