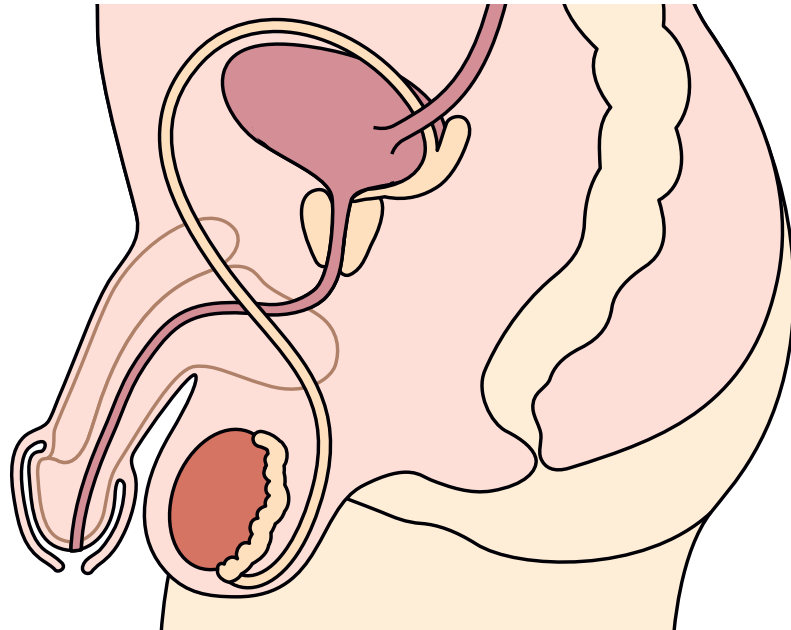

# Facts about the male reproductive system

## Definitions

- \_\_\_\_\_ Sac of skin that holds the testicles just underneath the penis
- \_\_\_\_\_ Two glands on either side of bladder that secrete seminal fluid
- \_\_\_\_\_ Two oval shaped organs contained in the scrotum, which produce the male hormone testosterone and sperm (also called the testes)
- \_\_\_\_\_ The tube-like sex organ of males which hangs outside of the body
- \_\_\_\_\_ A gland near the bladder that adds fluid to semen
- \_\_\_\_\_ The tube that at different times carries urine and semen out of the body
- \_\_\_\_\_ The thin long tubes through which sperm travel from the testicles, and where sperm are mixed with other fluid to make semen
- \_\_\_\_\_ A sac inside the abdomen that holds urine
- \_\_\_\_\_ The skin around the head of an uncircumcised penis
